Notes for the Raters:

1. Students should number the sections (2.1, 3.2.1., etc) correctly and write the headings in accordance with the rules we have taught (by capitalizing each word, bold, 12 type size) e.g. **3.2.1. Company Policies**. If the student fails to apply the rules in their writing, please decrease the rate 1 point. For example, if you rate the work as 4, decrease it to 3 if the student didn't apply the rules (capitalizing each word, bold, 12 type size).

2. Students should follow the order they use in the outline. They should not change the order or skip any parts.

3. Students should explain the sub-sections with some details (e.g. Examples, statistical information, historical information).

4. They should choose appropriate visual elements for their topic. For instance, they should prefer a pie chart to show the percentages of the company, or a table to demonstrate the numbers in the last decade, etc.

5. Students should apply the rules they have studied in the class regarding the visual, (e.g. its title, number and size.) in their report.

7. Students should not make serious mistakes, such as problems in SVO order, use of choppy sentences, sentence fragments, run-on sentences, overuse of "there is/are" and so forth.

9. The students are expected to connect the ideas using appropriate linkers according to the relationship between the ideas (reason-result / purpose / order, etc.).

10. They should avoid wordy phrases, unnecessary words, repetition of some words/phrases, and should prefer formal words.
